Updated Red Flag Rules

If you are on a court when the Red Flag is raised, limited play rules apply.

- Doubles players are limited to two sets.
- Singles players are limited to one set. Singles players that have been rallying for over 30 minutes should open their court immediately.

When the red flag is raised, singles players in their second set and doubles players in their third set may complete their set or relinquish their court, at their discretion. All players must relinquish their court after their limited play. They may immediately register on the chalkboard for the next available court.

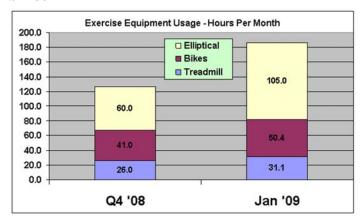
