



House & Grounds News

Parking - As you should be aware, the PTC does not "own" any parking spaces. The spots located along side BHS belong to the high school district. The PTC and BHS have a long standing relationship which permits us



to use these (yellow outlined) spots and only these spots. Members must refrain from parking in spots that are reserved for faculty, staff, students, and visitors (white lined spaces). They have told us that tickets will be issued. A second issue concerns high school students of PTC members. Students of members may NOT park in any of the spaces reserved for the PTC. In

addition we ask that students refrain from parking within 100 feet of the Chatham entrance. While the spaces are "public", we have older members who need to park closer to the club. We ask our members with BHS students to mention these issues to them.

Water Fountain - House and grounds has

been working on a number of issues, most go unnoticed as we hope they do. However, one that is on the minds of many is the status of adding a water fountain back by courts 3 & 7. I am happy to report that after a long search we have found a fountain that we feel will meet with our long term needs. On the right is a picture of the fountain that we have ordered. Due to manufacturing lead times, we do not expect to receive the fountain until late March. Once it arrives we will work to have it installed, but this too requires us to install the water and drain lines and pour a concrete pad. One thing you may noticed from the

picture is that the fountain

does not provide for "chilled" water. The Board discussed this and based on comments received and a cost that is a factor of 4x to provide a chilled water fountain, the decision was to move forward with a fountain that will provide water directly from the city line. In most cases we expect this will be cool enough.

Pool / **Spa** - There have been requests to increase the temperature of the spa. This issue has been investigated and the spa is currently set at its maximum temperature. We are unable to increase it further. Our pool consultant is contacting the heater manufacturer to see if anything can be done.

2009 Summer Program information is on the RS Academy website at www.rstennis.com. Member Registration is now open. Non-member registration starts in April.



TIP OF THE MONTH

Well this month the TOTM is a way to show good sportsmanship and tennis etiquette. My dad used to do this when we played and he never told me to do it but I just picked it up from him.

Whenever an opponent hits one of those outstanding shots that you marvel at just tap your racket strings twice with your non playing hand like you are clapping. This is old school but I think we should bring it back. I don't do it every time someone hits a winner but if I feel that the shot was just way too good then it deserves a little more than the customary "good shot." I'll either raise my racket about head high or just clap waist high. To me there is a little too much of the fist pumping bravado of the modern game going on. Show a little respect for your opponent's good tennis and you may even be prepared to handle the quality of their play down the line.
