Members, this is my final message to you as club President. I wanted to say thank you to everyone at the club for all of your input and help this past year. It has been great hearing from you and wonderful to have your assistance. Our club truly works well because its members contribute so much.

I also encourage each of you to attend the Annual Membership meeting on Tuesday, January 15 at 6:30 pm. 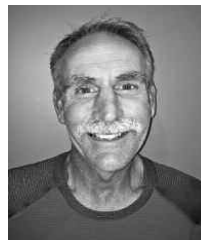

(b) A set shall be completed at 6-all by a tie breaker. (c) You can post your name on the wait list board ONLY when all members of your group are present. Please respect your fellow members and remember you are on the honor system to follow all club rules.

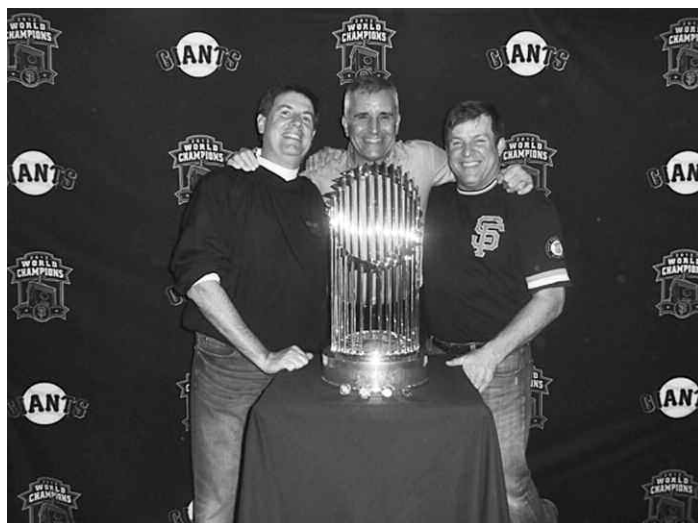

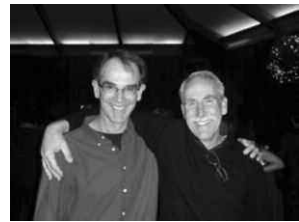
