Additionally, the Board awarded an Honorary Membership to **Betty Cookson**. Betty has been



She has also been heavily involved with running the Nike Junior, Cal State Senior, and Bonnebell MCB Cup.

These club achievements dwarf in comparison to her tennis achievements. There are too many to list, but some highlights include being inducted into the Norcal, Tennis Hall of Fame 1997, being nationally ranked #1, 2, or 3 in 55D, 60D, 65D from 1072-1989, becoming a Double Grand Slam winner 2008 W85, a Double Gold Ball winner in 2012 for W90 Clay & Hard Court Doubles, and most recently, becoming the current 2013 W90 National USTA Champion. Betty is still going strong on the courts, and we are very lucky to have her as part of PTC during the last 55 years.


