Wow! What an interesting show about the early days of the PTC that **Rob Delantoni** and the Membership Committee put on in our clubhouse Sunday afternoon, May 16, for the entertainment/enlightenment of the Burlingame Historical Society. Did you know that our old photos and scrapbooks were on their way to the trash collectors several years ago? Fortunately, they were rescued, scanned, digitized, and so some 2000 images were saved. Many photos showed people who were not identified, and it was fun to hear people in the audience, including old-timers **Kent Lauder & Bill Sherrard**, sing out, "That's my grandmother," and "That's my dad." It was a rousing slide show Rob gave on a big wide screen, and there was much good-natured give and take from the audience – including colorful tidbits of the past from **Dyle Anderson & Tom Brown**.

Bet you didn't know the following: where our PTC now is/was in the early 1930s, pastureland for cattle, horses, and a polo field... that our founding fathers had the chance to buy up all the land from here to the shores of San Francisco Bay for about \$900 (too much of a princely sum in those days, so they passed)... in the beginning, this was a do-it-yourself club - members chipped in to cut the lawn, mark the lines, and tend the dirt (clay) courts... At a match in 1936, early member Elia Fottrell beat the legendary British champ, Fred Perry.... In 1948, we bid for - and got the National Junior Hardcourts, held here from 1949-1989. Jimmy Connors, Pancho Gonzales, **Erik van Dillen**, Ann Kiyomura, Billie Jean King, Pete Sampras, Jennifer Capriati, Roscoe Tanner, and Pat McEnroe were among those who went on to the big time...Bing Crosby, then a Hillsborough resident, opened the Junior tournament one year...Why did that tournament leave? "They simply outgrew us," Rob explained... the California State Championships, now known as the California State Seniors, has been held here since 1962... At a doubles match for 55 year olds in 1974, our venerable **Sardis Farmer** (and partner) beat, of all people, Don Budge!... And how about the flags of 13 nations displayed in our clubroom? They were left here as thanks for our having hosted a major international event in 1992, the annual von Cramm Cup, named for the famous German player of pre-World War II. These were just some of the highlights from a fast-moving hour. Thanks for the memories, Rob! Hope such a show can be given again.
