

Club Improvement Committee

From a financial standpoint, the PTC is healthy. Let me share a few facts with you as we head into 2016. The day-to-day operational fund will finish in the black for 2015. The club

has not raised the \$95/month operational fee since 2007 despite the cost of most everything going up. Through ongoing efforts by *Lona*, lower water costs, and using *Loel* for most of the ongoing maintenance issues, we have been able to offset many cost increases with savings in other areas.

We are currently working on the 2016 operational budget and will present an update on how we finished 2015 and an outlook for 2016 at the January Membership Meeting. The Capital Reserve Fund is used for ongoing improvements to the Club. The new patio heaters, pool furniture, future men's locker room upgrades, etc. are all paid from this fund. As we end 2015, the Capital Reserve Fund will have over \$500k.

Finally, we have the Capital Loan Repayment Fund which is used to pay the monthly mortgage on the Capital Improvements completed in 2008. The Capital Loan Fund currently has \$400k. The current loan has a balloon payment due in Dec. 2018 at which time should be closer to \$450k. When the loan comes due, the club will apply the excess funds to pay down the current balance prior to refinancing the balance. Each of these three funds is unique and
